

Creating Your Account


- 1. Visit the UCCS Sona page.
- 2. Scroll down to "I am a Participant"
- 3. Review the participant information, tutorial video, and FAQs.




- 4. After reviewing the UCCS Sona website, participant information, tutorial info, and FAQs, gather the following information, which can be found in your course syllabus:
 - a. Correct Psych course number
 - b. Course section number
 - c. Instructor name
- 5. Click the Sona link to create your account.


6. Click "Request Account"




7. Provide the information asked using your UCCS username and UCCS ID number.




- 8. Once you have requested an account, go to your UCCS email where you will find the login information needed to enter Sona.
 - a. If you did not receive your login information, please check your email program's junk mail folder before contacting the administrator.
- 9. From the email, click the <u>Sona link</u> to log in using the username (your UCCS email address) and password found in that email.
- 10. Set up a different password and alternate email address.



11. Acknowledge the human subjects/privacy policy notice.




12. Click "view available studies" to get started. Welcome to Sona!



Signing Up for Sona Studies

- 1. After logging in to your account, click the "View Available Studies" link.
- 2. Here, you will see the study, how many points its worth, its eligibility requirements, and if it has availability.
- 3. To sign up, click on "Timeslots Available."
 - a. If there are times available, you will participate via:
 - An online web study that can be completed at any time up until the Participation Deadline Date. Be sure to read the details of online studies closely.
 - ii. A standard lab study where participation is in-person during a chosen available timeslot.

Study Participation and Attendance Policies

- 1. Don't wait until the last weeks of the semester to sign up for studies! There may not be any more studies available.
- 2. Please remember that signing up for a study means making a commitment to show up for that appointment. A participant should only sign up for a study if they can commit to the date/time.
- 3. Students who do not show up two times for studies, and do not cancel prior to the study, will be barred from signing up for any additional experiments.

Late Policy

- Participants who do not show up two times for studies per semester, and do not cancel prior to the study, will be unable from signing up for any additional studies.
- If a researcher is late or does not show up after 15 minutes after the appointment time, please email psych@uccs.edu. The participant is granted credit for the study participation when the researcher does not show up.
